HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO INCREASE ACTIVE PATROLS OF KAILUA BAY, EXPAND NO WAKE SPEED ZONES, AND ENFORCE BOATING SAFETY RULES.

1	WHEREAS, Hawaii's waters are an invaluable resource for
2	residents and tourists alike; and
3	
4	WHEREAS, many of the State's most cherished recreational
5	activities involve the ocean, including swimming, boating, free
6	diving, snorkeling, and paddling; and
7	
8	WHEREAS, the Division of Boating and Ocean Recreation
9	within the Department of Land and Natural Resources is tasked
10	with promoting and attaining the safety of persons using State
11	waters; and
12	
13	WHEREAS, one method of promoting and attaining water safety
14	is prohibiting boats in certain areas from traveling at speeds
15	above those that make the least possible wake; and
16	WHEREAS, Kailua Bay is one of the most popular beaches in
17	the State and attracts significant numbers of residents and
18 19	tourists each day who swim, dive, paddle, boat, and enjoy the
19 20	ocean; and

22	WHEREAS, in early 2016, a free diver was accidently killed
23	and another seriously injured in Kailua Bay when they were
24	struck by boat propellers; and

26	WHEREAS, as windward Oahu beaches continue to grow in
27	popularity, there is more opportunity for ocean goers to be
28	injured or killed by those who do not follow ocean safety
29	protocol; and

31	WHEREAS, increasing the presence of Department of Land and
32	Natural Resources officials in Kailua Bay would help deter

boaters from traveling above no wake speeds and violating other
 boating safety regulations, thus protecting ocean goers; now,
 therefore,

5 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 6 Twenty-eighth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 7 Session of 2016, that the Department of Land and Natural 8 Resources is urged to increase active patrols of Kailua Bay, 9 expand no wake speed zones, and enforce boating safety rules; 10 and
