RELATING TO TECHNOLOGY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 440G-8.1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 3 "(a) Every cable operator shall provide safe, adequate,
- 4 and reliable service in accordance with applicable laws, rules,
- 5 franchise requirements, and its filed schedule of terms and
- 6 conditions of service[-], including but not limited to
- 7 disclosing to customers and prospective customers the:
- 8 (1) Minimum bandwidth that shall be provided; and
- 9 (2) Maximum bandwidth available,
- 10 for cable communication services."
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 12 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 13 begun before its effective date.
- 14 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 16 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
