A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that greater coordination
- 2 among state and federal agencies is necessary to meet the food
- 3 sustainability goals of the Aloha+ Challenge. Food
- 4 sustainability is an ongoing concern for Hawaii, and a strategic
- 5 plan consistent with the goals of the Aloha+ Challenge is
- 6 necessary to help break the goal of food sustainability into
- 7 personalized objectives for departments and stakeholders.
- 8 Coordination and collaboration with all interested state and
- 9 federal agencies including but not limited to the United States
- 10 Department of Agriculture Child Nutrition Programs, the Hawaii
- 11 department of agriculture, department of education, and
- 12 department of public safety are necessary for the purpose of
- 13 working to achieve food sustainability in Hawaii.
- 14 The purpose of this Act is to establish a position within
- 15 the state procurement office for the purpose of developing and
- 16 executing a strategic plan, consistent with the Aloha+ Challenge
- 17 goals and objectives, for achieving food sustainability in

- 1 Hawaii through collaboration with all relevant state and federal
- 2 agencies.
- 3 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and
- 6 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 7 year 2016-2017 to fund a one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE)
- 8 position within the state procurement office tasked with
- 9 developing and executing a strategic plan, consistent with the
- 10 Aloha+ Challenge goals and objectives, for achieving food
- 11 sustainability in Hawaii through collaboration with all relevant
- 12 state and federal agencies.
- The sums appropriated shall be expended by the state
- 14 procurement office for the purposes of this Act.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
