A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STUDENT INSTRUCTIONAL TIME.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 302A-251, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "§302A-251 School year; instructional time. (a) 4 Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, beginning with 5 the [2011 2013] 2015-2016 school [years,] year, all public 6 schools, excluding charter schools and multi-track public 7 schools, shall implement a school year of one hundred eighty 8 days, excluding professional development days and other non-9 instructional days negotiated pursuant to chapter 89. 10 [(b) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary: 11 (1) For the 2011 2012 school year, fifty per cent of all 12 public elementary schools in the State, excluding 13 charter schools and multi-track public schools, shall 14 implement a school year that includes nine hundred 15 fifteen student instructional hours; and 16 (2) Beginning with the 2012-2013 school year, all public 17 elementary schools in the State, excluding charter

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1	schools and multi track public schools, shall
2	implement a school year that includes nine hundred
3	fifteen student instructional hours.
4	(c) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, for the
5	2014-2016 school years, all public secondary schools, excluding
6	charter schools and multi-track public schools, shall implement
7	a-school year that includes nine hundred ninety student
8	instructional hours.
9	(d) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, for the
10	2016-2018 school years, all public schools, excluding charter
11	schools and multi-track public schools, shall implement a school
12	year of one hundred eighty days, excluding professional
13	development days and other non-instructional days negotiated
14	pursuant to chapter 89, that shall include one thousand eighty
15	student instructional hours for both elementary and secondary
16	school grades.
17	(e) The board, in its discretion, may grant a waiver to
18	any individual school subject to the student instructional hours
19	or one hundred eighty day school year requirements in this
20	section. The board shall adopt policies and procedures to grant
21	a waiver under this subsection.

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(f) For purposes of this section, "student instructional
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    hours" means student learning time during which students are
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    engaged in learning activities including regularly scheduled
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    instruction and learning assessments within the curriculum, and
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    does not include lunch, recess, or passing time.
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         (g) (b) The department of education, with the board of
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    education and office of the governor, and in consultation with
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    representatives of the affected collective bargaining units,
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    shall submit to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
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    to the convening of the regular sessions of 2013, 2014, 2015,
    2016, 2017, and 2018, a report on its progress and efforts to
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    meet the requirements of [subsections (a), (b), (c), and (d).]
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    this section."
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         SECTION 2. Act 167, Session Laws of Hawaii 2010, is
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    amended by repealing section 4.
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         ["SECTION 4. The department of education shall, with the
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    board of education and office of the governor, and in
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    consultation with representatives of the affected collective
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    bargaining units, submit to the legislature, no later than
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    twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session of
    2012, a plan to implement a school year of one hundred ninety
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- 1 days, excluding professional development days and other non-
- 2 instructional days negotiated pursuant to chapter 89, Hawaii
- 3 Revised Statutes, that shall include one thousand one hundred
- 4 forty student instructional hours for both elementary and
- 5 secondary school grades at all public schools, except charter
- 6 schools, for school years beginning with the 2015 2016 school
- 7 year. For purposes of this section, "student instructional
- 8 hours shall have the same meaning as in section 302A ...,
- 9 Hawaii Revised Statutes."]
- 10 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
