BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to authorize the procurement policy board to adopt administrative rules pursuant to section 103D-202, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to provide an

5 committee is unable to send three or more qualified persons'

6 submittals to provide professional services to the head of the

purchasing agency pursuant to section 103D-304, Hawaii Revised

9 SECTION 2. Section 103D-304, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 10 amended by amending subsection (g) to read as follows:

"(g) The selection committee shall rank a minimum of three persons based on the selection criteria and send the ranking to the head of the purchasing agency. In the event there are fewer than three qualified persons on the list prepared pursuant to subsections (b) and (c), the selection committee, pursuant to subsection (d), shall rank the qualified persons based on the

subsection (d), shall rank the qualified persons based on the

17 selection criteria and send the ranking to the chief procurement

- 1 officer who may proceed in accordance with administrative rules
- 2 adopted by the procurement policy board.
- 3 The contract file shall contain a copy of the summary of
- 4 qualifications for the ranking of each of the persons provided
- 5 to the head of the purchasing agency for contract negotiations.
- 6 If more than one person holds the same qualifications under this
- 7 section, the selection committee shall rank the persons in a
- 8 manner that ensures equal distribution of contracts among the
- 9 persons holding the same qualifications. The recommendations of
- 10 the selection committee shall not be overturned without due
- 11 cause."
- 12 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Procurement; Professional Services; Minimum Three Qualified

Description:

Authorizes the Procurement Policy Board to adopt rules addressing situations of fewer than three qualified persons for procurement of professional services. Allows the Chief Procurement Officer to proceed with procurement in according with the adopted rules. (SB1064 HD1)
