- 12 amended by adding a new section to article 1 to be appropriately
- 13 designated and to read as follows:
- 14 "\$432:1- Habilitative services. "Habilitative services"
- 15 means health care services, including but not limited to
- 16 physical and occupational therapy, speech-language therapy,
- 17 speech and swallowing therapy, applied behavior analysis,



- 1 medical equipment, orthotics, and prosthetics, that help a
- 2 person keep, learn, or improve skills and functioning for daily
