- 7 workers' compensation law and set the benefit for chiropractic
- 8 and acupuncture treatments at thirty visits at no more than \$75
- 9 per visit. Acupuncture codes were not included in the medicare
- 10 fee schedule as of the effective date of Act 251, and
- 11 acupuncturists were therefore placed under the same restrictions
- 12 as chiropractors. The benefit allowed for acupuncture
- 13 treatments has not increased in nearly twenty years, while rates
- 14 for other services, such as physical therapy and medical office
- 15 visits, have increased over the years.
- 16 The purpose of this Act is to increase the authorized
- 17 benefit for acupuncture treatments allowed under personal injury
- 18 protection benefits provided through motor vehicle insurance.



- 1 SECTION 2. Section 431:10C-103.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
- 2 is amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 3 "(c) Acupuncture treatments shall be allowed for no more
- 4 than thirty visits at no more than [\$75] \$ a visit [-];
- 5 provided that the maximum payment amount under this subsection
- 6 shall be increased in December of each year by the same
- 7 percentage of increase, if any, of the medicare economic index
- 8 for that calendar year from the medicare economic index for the
- 9 prior calendar year."
- 10 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2053.
