A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§302A- Sex education and education on sexually
- 5 transmitted diseases. (a) Schools shall obtain written
- 6 parental consent prior to providing any instruction to students
- 7 on sex education and sexually transmitted diseases. Children
- 8 whose parents do not provide consent shall not attend or
- 9 participate in the instruction.
- 10 (b) Parents of students shall receive notice in advance to
- 11 provide a reasonable opportunity to provide or withhold consent
- 12 in writing for the student's attendance."
- 13 SECTION 2. Section 321-111, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 14 amended as follows:
- 1. By amending subsection (a) to read:
- 16 "(a) The departments of health and education shall
- 17 cooperate with each other and other public and private

- 1 authorities as they may deem advisable for the education of
- 2 minors and members of the general public on sexually transmitted
- 3 diseases and the prevention of sexually transmitted diseases.
- 4 For the purpose of this section, "minor" means any person
- 5 [fourteen years of age or older and] under the age of majority."
- 6 2. By amending subsection (c) to read:
- 7 "(c) The information shall be made available upon request
- 8 to all minors in the department of education with written
- 9 parental consent and members of the general public [without
- 10 parental consent] and the information shall be distributed to
- 11 all public school counselors requesting educational materials
- 12 concerning sexually transmitted disease prevention, detection,
- 13 and treatment."
- 14 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 16 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval
- 17 and shall apply commencing with the 2015-2014 school year.
