RELATING TO LAW ENFORCEMENT.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 26-19, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§26-19 Department of transportation. The department of
- 4 transportation shall be headed by a single executive to be known
- 5 as the director of transportation. The department shall
- 6 establish, maintain, and operate transportation facilities of
- 7 the State, including highways, airports, harbors, and such other
- 8 transportation facilities and activities as may be authorized by
- 9 law[-]; provided that non-state employees shall be prohibited
- 10 from exercising any law enforcement functions and authorities of
- 11 the department of transportation.
- 12 The department shall plan, develop, promote, and coordinate
- 13 various transportation systems management programs that shall
- 14 include, but not be limited to, alternate work and school hours
- 15 programs, bicycling programs, and ridesharing programs.
- 16 The department shall develop and promote ridesharing
- 17 programs which shall include but not be limited to, carpool and

- vanpool programs, and may assist organizations interested in 1
- 2 promoting similar programs, arrange for contracts with private
- 3 organizations to manage and operate these programs, and assist
- in the formulation of ridesharing arrangements. Ridesharing 4
- 5 programs include informal arrangements in which two or more
- persons ride together in a motor vehicle. 6
- The functions and authority heretofore exercised by the 7
- department of public works with respect to highways are 8
- transferred to the department of transportation established by 9
- 10 this chapter.
- On July 1, 1961, the Hawaii aeronautics commission, the 11
- board of harbor commissioners and the highway commission shall 12
- be abolished and their remaining functions, duties, and powers 13
- shall be transferred to the department of transportation." 14
