A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
TWENTY-THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
general obligation bonds in the sum of \$112,166,000 or so much
thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof
as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2015-2016
for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the twenty-
third senatorial district, as follows:

1. Ahuimanu elementary school

A. Drainage.

14 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at

15 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are

16 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are

17 unencumbered as of June 30, 2018, shall lapse as of that date.

18 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective

19 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be

20 expended by the appropriate expending agency for the purposes of

21 this Act.
