- 1 SECTION 1. Section 291C-77, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

- 3 "§291C-77 Pedestrians soliciting rides, business or
- 4 attention of motorist. (a) Except as otherwise provided by
- 5 county ordinance, no person shall stand in, walk along, or
- 6 otherwise occupy a portion of a highway for the purpose of
- 7 soliciting a ride, employment, business, or contributions from
- 8 the occupant of any vehicle.
- 9 (b) No person shall stand on or in proximity to a street
- 10 or highway for the purpose of soliciting the watching or
- 11 guarding of any vehicle while parked or about to be parked on a
- 12 street or highway.
- 13 [(c) Except as otherwise provided by county ordinance, no
- 14 person shall hold or display a movable sign within the right of
- 15 way boundaries of a public highway or on the sidewalk abutting a
- 16 public highway or in an area adjacent to the highway for the
- 17 purpose of carrying on political campaign activities as defined
