### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO METHAMPHETAMINE TRAFFICKING.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 712-1240.7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows: 3 "(1) A person commits the offense of methamphetamine 4 trafficking in the first degree if the person knowingly: 5 Possesses one or more preparations, compounds, (a) 6 mixtures, or substances of an aggregate weight of one 7 ounce or more containing methamphetamine or any of its salts, isomers, and salts of isomers; 9 (b) Distributes one or more preparations, compounds, 10 mixtures, or substances of an aggregate weight of 11 [one-eighth] one-half ounce or more containing 12 methamphetamine or any of its salts, isomers, and salts of isomers; 13 14 (c) Distributes methamphetamine in any amount to a minor; 15 or 16 Manufactures methamphetamine in any amount." (d)
