BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 103D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately		
3	designated and to read as follows:		
4	"§103D- Statewide procurement database. (a) The state		
5	procurement office shall establish and maintain a database of		
6	all procurement contract data received pursuant to subsection		
7	(b); provided that all data on the database shall be made		
8	accessible to each governmental body.		
9	(b) Each governmental body shall provide to the state		
10	procurement office high level contract fields, as defined by the		
11	state procurement office, to allow for transparency in		
12	contracting. Fields shall include but not be limited to:		
13	(1) The posted date of the award;		
14	(2) Contract number;		
15	(3) Department name;		
16	(4) Contract description;		
17	(5) Awardee;		
18	(6) Fiscal year;		

1	(7)	Total funding;	
2	(8)	Method of source selection;	
3	(9)	Contract status;	
4	(10)	<pre>Internet website address;</pre>	
5	(11)	Small business status; and	
6	(12)	Period of performance.	
7	Information shall be provided in the form and manner prescribed		
8	by the state procurement office and for inclusion in the		
9	database	established under subsection (a)."	
10	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general		
11	revenues	of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so	
12	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and		
13	the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal		
14	year 2016-2017 for the state procurement office to establish the		
15	statewide	e procurement database pursuant to this Act.	
16	The	sums appropriated shall be expended by the department	
17	of accour	ting and general services for the purposes of this Act.	
18	SECT	TION 3. New statutory material is underscored.	
19	SECT	TION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
