A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that investment in
- 2 renewable energy yields a return in economic growth, job growth,
- 3 and progress toward energy sustainability. Ocean thermal energy
- 4 conversion is a renewable energy technology that is particularly
- 5 suited to Hawaii's geography. It uses the variation between
- 6 warm water on the ocean's surface and cold water in the ocean's
- 7 depths to drive a steam cycle that turns a turbine and produces
- 8 power. The system produces energy twenty-four hours a day and
- 9 does not pollute the environment. The State's tropical location
- 10 is ideal for ocean thermal energy conversion, and the State
- 11 could serve as the frontier for further development of this
- 12 technology.
- The introduction of an ocean thermal energy conversion
- 14 plant would bring jobs in science, engineering, and technology
- 15 to Hawaii. The energy harnessed by the technology would bring
- 16 the State closer to its goal of energy sustainability, and some
- 17 of the money currently flowing out of the State to purchase

- 1 fossil fuels could be kept within the State, further bolstering
- 2 the local economy.
- 3 The purpose of this Act is to fund ocean thermal energy
- 4 conversion projects in the State.
- 5 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$5,000,000 or so much
- 7 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and the
- 8 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 9 2016-2017 to fund ocean thermal energy conversion projects in
- 10 the State.
- 11 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 12 of business, economic development, and tourism for the purpose
- 13 of this Act.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
