10	(3)	The liquor commission monitors the event;
11	(4)	All sales and consumption of liquor are contained
12		within designated "beer garden" areas at the event;

14	(5)	All vendors that sell liquor at the event report gross
15		liquor sales to the liquor commission of the county in
16		which the event is held.
17	(b)	The liquor commission may adopt rules necessary to

carry out the intent and purpose of this section.
