## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO VOTING.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended 2 by adding a new section to part II be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§11- Applications for a driver's license or state
- 5 identification card. (a) Notwithstanding any law to the
- 6 contrary, an affidavit on application for voter registration
- 7 shall be a part of the application associated with the issuance
- 8 of a civil identification card under section 286-301 and
- 9 driver's license under section 286-109.
- 10 (b) Applications for a civil identification card or
- 11 driver's license will not be processed until the applicant
- 12 clearly indicates on the application that they are declining to
- 13 register to vote or the portion of the application related to
- 14 voter registration is completed."
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 286-109, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 "§286-109 General provision governing the issuance of
- 18 licenses. (a) Upon payment of the required fee and upon 2015-1131 SB150 SD1 SMA.doc

- 2 categories of motor vehicles to the satisfaction of the examiner
- 3 of drivers, an applicant for a driver's license shall be issued
- 4 a single license of a design approved by the director of
- 5 transportation upon which is made a notation of:
- 6 (1) The category or categories of motor vehicles the7 applicant may operate;
- 8 (2) Any restrictive provisions to which the license is9 subject;
  - (3) Veteran status, if desired by the applicant; provided that the notation shall be on the front of the license and shall not include any designation other than the term "veteran"; and
- 14 (4) When the license is issued to a person under twenty15 one years of age, a statement, in clearly legible
  16 print that shall contrast with the other information
  17 appearing on the license, which indicates the date on

- 1 As used in this subsection, "veteran" means any person who
- 2 served in any of the uniformed services of the United States and
- 3 was discharged under conditions other than dishonorable.
- 4 (b) The examiner of drivers shall not issue or renew any
- 5 driver's license using the driver's social security number on
- 6 the driver's license.
- 7 (c) Statutes of limitations and other provisions of this
- 8 chapter notwithstanding, no driver's license or instruction
- 9 permit shall be issued or renewed under this section, where the
- 10 examiner of drivers is notified by the district judge, traffic
- 11 violations bureaus of the district courts, or the judge of the
- 12 circuit court that the applicant has failed to respond to a
- 13 traffic citation or summons, or failed to appear in court after
- 14 an arrest for the violation of any traffic laws of a county,
- 15 this chapter or chapter 286G, 287, 290, 291, or 291C, or of any
- 16 motor vehicle insurance laws under article 10C of chapter 431,
- 17 or of any motorcycle or motor scooter insurance laws under
- 18 article 10G of chapter 431, and the same remains delinquent and
- 19 outstanding, or the applicant, has as of the time of the
- 20 application, failed to comply in full with all orders of the
- 21 court; provided that the district court with whose order an

- 1 applicant has failed to comply in full, may approve the issuance
- 2 or renewal of a driver's license or instruction permit other
- 3 than a commercial driver's license upon conditions imposed by
- 4 the court for the satisfaction of the outstanding court order
- 5 and any other conditions as may be imposed by the court, if one
- 6 or more of the following conditions are met:
- 7 (1) The applicant is gainfully employed in a position that
- 8 requires driving and will be discharged if the
- 9 applicant is unable to drive; or
- 10 (2) The applicant has no access to alternative
- 11 transportation and therefore must drive to work;
- 12 provided further that if the applicant has failed to comply in
- 13 full with orders of the district court of more than one circuit,
- 14 the applicant shall obtain the approval of the district court of
- 15 each circuit in which the applicant has an outstanding court
- 16 order before a driver's license or instruction permit may be
- 17 issued or renewed under this subsection.
- 18 A driver's license or instruction permit issued or renewed
- 19 under this subsection shall be subject to immediate suspension
- 20 by the court upon the applicant's failure to remain in full
- 21 compliance with all conditions imposed by the court for the

- 1 issuance or renewal of the driver's license or instruction
- 2 permit. The examiner of drivers may place an indication of
- 3 restriction upon a driver's license or instruction permit issued
- 4 or renewed under this subsection. Proof of financial
- 5 responsibility under section 287-20 shall not apply to the
- 6 issuance or renewal of driver's licenses or instruction permits
- 7 under this subsection.
- 8 (d) An application for a driver's license shall include
- 9 the information required under section 11- ."
- 10 SECTION 3. Section 286-301, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 11 amended to read as follows:
- 12 "[+]§286-301[+] Issuance of identification card or
- 13 temporary card. (a) To obtain an identification card from the
- 14 examiner of drivers, an individual shall complete an application
- 15 pursuant to section 286-303.
- 16 (b) The examiner of drivers, upon receipt of the
- 17 application by any individual who is a resident or a temporary
- 18 resident of this State, shall issue an identification card to
- 19 that individual upon receipt of any appropriate fee established
- 20 pursuant to section 286-309.

The identification card shall be similar in size, 1 shape, and design to a driver's license, but shall not entitle 2 the individual to whom it is issued to operate a motor vehicle. 3 The issuance of an identification card pursuant to (d) 4 this section shall not place upon the State of Hawaii or any 5 agency any liability for the misuse or the acceptance of the 6 identification card as valid identification, which shall be left 7 entirely to the discretion of any individual to whom such card 8 9 is presented. (e) An application for an identification card from the 10 examiner of drivers shall include the information required under 11 12 section 11- ." SECTION 4. Section 286-311, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 13 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 14 [All] Except for purposes of sections 286-109 and 15 286-301, information and records acquired by the examiner of 16 drivers under this part shall be confidential. All information 17 and records shall be maintained in an appropriate form and in an 18 appropriate office in the custody and under the control of the 19 examiner. The information shall be available only to authorized 20 individuals under such restrictions as the director shall 21

- 1 prescribe. The examiner may dispose of any application or
- 2 identification card, or information or record relating to the
- 3 application or identification card, which does not include a
- 4 social security number, without regard to chapter 94, whenever,
- 5 in the examiner's discretion, retention of the information or
- 6 record is no longer required or practicable."
- 7 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
