15	(6)	Undertake the program of centralized engineering and
16		office leasing services, including operation [and],



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1		maintenance, lease negotiation, and lease processing
2		of public buildings, for departments of the State;
3	(7)	Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary,
4		negotiate and process leases of private real property
5		for departments and agencies of the State;
6	[(7)]	(8) Undertake the functions of the state surveyor;
7	[-(8)]	(9) Establish accounting and internal control
8	· .	systems;
9	[-(9) -]	(10) Provide centralized computer information
10		management and processing services, coordination in
11		the use of all information processing equipment,
12		software, facilities, and services in the executive
13		branch of the State, and consultation and support
14		services in the use of information processing and
15		management technologies to improve the efficiency,
16		effectiveness, and productivity of state government
