A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WATERSHED PROTECTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 183, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to part III to be appropriately designated and to read as follows:

"§183- Watershed initiatives program; established.

There shall be established within the department a watershed initiatives program, which shall plan, monitor, and execute watershed protection initiatives. The board shall employ necessary staff, including professional, administrative, and clerical employees, to execute the program; provided that the employees shall be subject to chapter 76."

SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2016-2017 for the establishment of a watershed initiatives program.




1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
