A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE CULTURAL EXCHANGES BETWEEN HAWAII AND AFRICAN AMERICANS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that since the arrival of
- 2 the first people of African descent in Hawaii between 1778 and
- 3 1850, people of African descent have contributed significantly
- 4 to all phases of Hawaii's development. The rich culture and
- 5 proud heritage of people of African descent have been and
- 6 continue to be positive influences upon life in Hawaii.
- 7 However, little of this history is known or preserved due to a
- 8 lack of understanding and racial divides. Recognition of the
- 9 contributions of people of African descent and their culture is
- 10 important to the promotion and awareness of Hawaii's diverse and
- 11 multicultural society.
- 12 The purpose of this Act is to establish a commission on the
- 13 history and culture of people of African descent to recognize
- 14 the contributions of people of African descent in Hawaii and
- 15 educate Hawaii's citizens.

- 1 SECTION 2. (a) There is established a commission to be
- 2 known as the Hawaii commission on the history and culture of
- 3 people of African descent.
- 4 (b) The commission shall be temporarily placed within the
- 5 department of accounting and general services for administrative
- 6 purposes. The commission shall be dissolved on June 30, 2017.
- 7 (c) The Hawaii commission on the history and culture of
- 8 people of African descent shall consist of eleven members to be
- 9 appointed by the governor without regard to section 26-34,
- 10 Hawaii Revised Statutes. The members shall include:
- 11 (1) Two members representing the African American
- 12 Diversity Culture Center Hawaii;
- 13 (2) Two members representing the National Association for
- 14 the Advancement of Colored People;
- 15 (3) One member representing the University of Hawaii; and
- 16 (4) Six at-large members.
- 17 (d) The chair of the commission shall be selected by a
- 18 majority vote of the commission members.
- 19 (e) The members shall not receive compensation for their
- 20 services but shall be reimbursed for necessary expenses,

- 2 duties under this section.
- 3 (f) The Hawaii commission on the history and culture of
- 4 people of African descent may:
- 5 (1) Initiate, direct, and coordinate projects and events
- 6 to further the understanding of the history and
- 7 culture of people of African descent;
- **8** (2) Educate residents and visitors to the State about the
- 9 significance and impact of the experience of people of
- 10 African descent in Hawaii; and
- 11 (3) Publish an annual report to the legislature with
- 12 recommendations to honor and recognize the
- contributions of people of African descent in Hawaii.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015; and
- 15 shall be repealed on June 30, 2017.
