BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 134-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 2
- 3 Any person of the age of sixteen years, or over or
- 4 any person [under the age of sixteen] from the age of ten to
- 5 fifteen years while accompanied by an adult, may carry and use
- any lawfully acquired rifle or shotgun and suitable ammunition 6
- 7 while actually engaged in hunting or target shooting or while
- 8 going to and from the place of hunting or target shooting;
- 9 provided that the person has procured a hunting license under
- chapter 183D, part II. A hunting license shall not be required 10
- for persons engaged in target shooting." 11
- 12 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 13
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
