### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE USE OF INTOXICANTS WHILE OPERATING A VEHICLE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 291E-61, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- "(a) A person commits the offense of operating a vehicle
  under the influence of an intoxicant if the person operates or
  sassumes actual physical control of a vehicle:
- 6 (1) While under the influence of alcohol in an amount
  7 sufficient to impair the person's normal mental
  8 faculties or ability to care for the person and guard
  9 against casualty;
  - (2) While under the influence of any drug that impairs the person's ability to operate the vehicle in a careful and prudent manner;
- (3) With [.08] .06 or more grams of alcohol per two
  hundred ten liters of breath; or
- 15 (4) With [.08] .06 or more grams of alcohol per one

  16 hundred milliliters or cubic centimeters of blood."
