A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE AND RELATED DEMENTIA SERVICES COORDINATOR POSITION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the Hawaii 2025:
- 2 State Plan Alzheimer's Disease and Related Dementias, published
- 3 by the executive office on aging, identifies goals and key
- 4 strategies to improve the lives of the numerous families
- 5 affected by the disease. The legislature further finds that
- 6 Alzheimer's disease is the sixth leading cause of death in the
- 7 United States and that it affects twenty-six thousand Hawaii
- 8 residents, a number that will increase by forty per cent by the
- 9 year 2025. The legislature also finds that an estimated sixty-
- 10 five thousand unpaid caregivers in this State provide seventy-
- 11 four million hours of unpaid care each year.
- 12 With the significantly high number of individuals affected
- 13 by Alzheimer's disease as a person having the disease or as a
- 14 caregiver, and the substantial projected increase by 2025, there
- is a need for a coordinated and prepared support system to
- 16 address the multitude of issues arising from addressing the

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- 1 disease. While the Hawaii 2025: State Plan Alzheimer's Disease
- 2 and Related Dementias identifies strategies to address the
- 3 disease, the services and activities require coordination at a
- 4 systemic level, such as through a coordinator position.
- 5 The purpose of this Act is to make an appropriation for an
- 6 Alzheimer's disease and related dementia services coordinator
- 7 position.
- 8 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$70,000 or so much
- 10 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2016-2017 for the
- 11 Alzheimer's disease and related dementia services coordinator
- 12 position, exempt from chapter 76, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 13 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 14 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
