## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 489J, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "S489J- Drone operator liability insurance. (a) No
- 5 person shall own, operate, or control a drone unless the person
- 6 maintains at all times liability insurance in the amount of not
- 7 less than \$ \_\_\_\_.
- 8 (b) A violation of this section shall constitute an unfair
- 9 or deceptive act or practice under section 480-2.
- (c) As used in this section:
- 11 "Drone" means a powered, aerial vehicle that carries or is
- 12 equipped with a recording device that:
- 13 <u>(1)</u> Does not carry a human operator;
- 14 (2) Uses aerodynamic forces to provide vehicle lift;
- 15 (3) Can fly autonomously or be piloted remotely;
- 16 (4) Can be expendable or recoverable; and
- 17 (5) Can carry a lethal or nonlethal payload."

- SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that 1
- matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were 2
- begun before its effective date. 3
- SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored. 4
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
