BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

8		or cocaine or any of their respective salts,	
9		isomers, and salts of isomers; [ox]	
10	(ii)	One and one-half ounce or more, containing one or	
11		more of any of the other dangerous drugs except	
12		methamphetamine; or	
13	<u>(iii)</u>	Fifty or more capsules, tablets, ampules, dosage	
14		units, or syrettes containing one or more	
15		dangerous drugs;	
16	(b) Dist	ributes, except for methamphetamine:
