A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE SUSTAINABLE AND ORGANIC AGRICULTURE PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the sustainable and organic agriculture program administered by the University of Hawaii college of tropical agriculture and human resources is a part of the world's largest nontraditional education system, the
- 5 cooperative extension system. Across Hawaii, farmers are
- 6 experimenting with different ways of producing agricultural
- 7 products in ways that are sustainable and beneficial to the
- ${f 8}$ -social, economic, and environmental well-being of farm families
- 9 and the rural communities in which they live.
- The legislature further finds that the sustainable and organic agriculture program simultaneously focuses on three
- 12 equally important challenges:
- 13 (1) Providing a more profitable farm income;
- 14 (2) Promoting environmental stewardship; and
- 15 (3) Promoting stable, prosperous farm families and
- 16 communities.

1 However, without adequate funding and staff, the sustainable and 2 organic agriculture program is unable to fully meet its goals. 3 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate moneys for the 4 sustainable and organic agriculture program of the University of Hawaii college of tropical agriculture and human resources to 5 support the growth and sustainability of the local agriculture 6 7 industry. 8 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$250,000 or so much 10 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2016-2017 for the 11 sustainable and organic agriculture program administered by the 12 University of Hawaii college of tropical agriculture and human 13 resources that shall be allocated as follows: \$70,000 for one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) 14 (1) 15 educational assistant for the State; \$70,000 for one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) 16 (2) 17 research and extension assistant at the University of Hawaii at Manoa; 18 \$70,000 for one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) 19 (3) 20 research and extension assistant to serve the counties

of Hawaii, Kauai, and Maui; and

- \$40,000 for operating expenses. 1 (4)
- 2 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the University of
- Hawaii for the purposes of this Act. 3
- SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2016. 4
