BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 342D-9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

The notice shall specify the alleged violation and may contain an order specifying a reasonable time during which that person shall be required to take any measures that may be necessary to correct the violation and to give periodic progress reports; provided that if all attempts of service of process upon the alleged violator or violators are unsuccessful by personal delivery and by certified, registered, or express mail, notice may be given via a posting on a

searchable government website;

1	(2)	may require that the alleged violator or violators
2		appear before the director for a hearing at a time and
3		place specified in the notice and answer the charges

5	(3)	May impose penalties as provided in section 342D-31 by
6		sending written notice, either by certified mail or by
