### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTIONS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 11-137, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "\$11-137 Secrecy; removal or exhibition of ballot. No
- 4 person shall look at or ask to see the contents of the ballot or
- 5 the choice of party or nonpartisan ballot of any voter, except
- 6 as provided in section 11-139 and 11-132, nor shall any person
- 7 within the polling place attempt to influence a voter in regard
- 8 to whom the voter shall vote for. When a voter is in the voting
- 9 booth for the purpose of voting, no other person, except as
- 10 provided in section 11-139 and 11-132, shall be allowed to enter
- 11 the booth or to be in a position from which the person can
- 12 observe how the voter votes.
- 13 No person shall take a ballot out of the polling place
- 14 except as provided in sections 11-135 and 11-139. After voting
- 15 the voter shall leave the voting booth and deliver the voter's
- 16 ballot to the precinct official in charge of the ballot boxes.
- 17 The precinct official shall make certain that the precinct

- 1 official has received the correct ballot and no other and then
- shall deposit the ballot into the ballot box. No person shall 2
- 3 look at or ask to see the contents of the unvoted ballots. If
- 4 any person, other than the voter, having received a ballot
- 5 leaves the polling place without first delivering the ballot to
- 6 the precinct official as provided above, or wilfully exhibits
- 7 the [person's] voter's ballot or the [person's] voter's unvoted
- 8 ballots in a special primary or primary election, except as
- 9 provided in section 11-139 and 11-132, after the ballot has been
- 10 marked, the person shall forfeit the person's right to vote, and
- 11 the chairperson of the precinct officials shall cause a record
- 12 to be made of the proceeding[-]; provided that subject to
- sections 11-139 and 11-132, nothing in this section shall be 13
- 14 construed to diminish or extinguish a voter's right to exhibit
- the voter's own marked ballot electronically or digitally to 15
- 16 other persons."
- 17 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 18 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

#### Report Title:

Elections; Secrecy; Removal or Exhibition of Ballot

#### Description:

Prohibits any person from wilfully exhibiting another person's ballot or another person's unvoted ballots in a special primary or primary election, except as provided in sections 11-132 and 11-139, HRS, after the ballot has been marked. Preserves the right for any voter to exhibit the voter's own marked ballot electronically or digitally to other persons, subject to sections 11-132 and 11-139, HRS.
