A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TESTING FOR INTOXICANTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 291E-15, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "§291E-15 Refusal to submit to breath, blood, or urine 4 test; subject to administrative revocation proceedings. If a 5 person under arrest refuses to submit to a breath, blood, or 6 urine test, none shall be given, except as provided in section 7 291E-21. Upon the law enforcement officer's determination that 8 the person under arrest has refused to submit to a breath, 9 blood, or urine test, if applicable, then a law enforcement 10 officer shall: 11 Inform the person under arrest of the sanctions under (1) section 291E-41[-7] or 291E-65[-65]; and 12 13 (2) Ask the person if the person still refuses to submit 14 to a breath, blood, or urine test, thereby subjecting 15 the person to the procedures and sanctions under part III or section 291E-65, as applicable; 16

- 1 provided that if the law enforcement officer fails to comply
- 2 with paragraphs (1) and (2), the person shall not be subject to
- 3 the refusal sanctions under part III or IV."
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 291E-68, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 5 repealed.
- 6 ["\$291E-68 Refusal to submit to a breath, blood, or urine
- 7 test; penalty. Except as provided in section 291E-65, refusal
- 8 to submit to a breath, blood, or urine test as required by part
- 9 II is a petty-misdemeanor."]
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 11 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 12 begun before its effective date.
- 13 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
