BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 235, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated	
3	and to re	ad as follows:
4	" <u>§23</u>	5- Full-time employment incentive program. (a) A
5	small bus	iness that employs, for the duration of the taxable
6	year, nin	ety per cent of all of its employees as full-time
7	employees	may apply, in the form and manner prescribed by the
8	departmen	t of taxation, to receive a \$1,000 refund pursuant to
9	rules adopted by the department of taxation.	
10	(b)	For purposes of this section, "small business" means:
11	(1)	A corporation, partnership, sole proprietorship, or
12		other legal entity; or
13	(2)	A private, nonprofit, tax-exempt corporation,
14		association, or organization described in section
15		501(c)(3), Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended,
16		that:
17		(A) Is domiciled in this State;

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1	(B) Is independently owned and operated; and
2	(C) Employs fewer than one hundred full-time
3	employees."
4	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
5	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
6	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2016-2017 for
7	the full-time employment incentive program.
8	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
9	taxation for the purposes of this Act.
