### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MEDICAL MARIJUANA EDIBLE PRODUCTS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) The legislature shall convene a working group to research, discuss, and make recommendations for 2 legislation regarding edible medical marijuana products. 3 (b) The working group shall include the following: 4 Two senators from the senate committee on commerce, 5 (1) consumer protection, and health, to be appointed by 6 the senate president; 7 8 (2) Two members of the house of representatives committee 9 on health, to be appointed by the speaker of the house 10 of representatives; The director of health or the director's designee; 11 (3) 12 (4)Two community members who represent the dispensary 13 licensees, to be appointed by the governor; 14 One member from the Drug Policy Forum of Hawaii; (5) 15 (6) Two registered medical marijuana patients, to be 16 appointed by the governor;

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1	(7)	Two medical marijuana manufacturers currently making
2		marijuana products, to be appointed by the governor;
3		and
4	(8)	The director of commerce and consumer affairs or the
5		director's designee.
6	(c)	One senator shall be designated by the senate
7	president	and one member of the house of representatives shall
8	be design	ated by the speaker of the house of representatives to
9	co-chair	the working group.
10	(d)	The working group shall meet a minimum of four times
11	before Ja	nuary 1, 2017, to discuss:
12	(1)	New medical marijuana edible products, including
13		drinks, for patients;
14	(2)	Packaging for medical marijuana edible products;
15	(3)	Best practices in other states;
16	(4)	Quality control and potency of medical marijuana
17		edible products; and
18	(5)	Any other pertinent issues relating to medical
19		marijuana products that may be sold at medical

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marijuana dispensaries.

- 1 (e) The working group meetings shall be open to the public
- 2 and shall include a segment for public comment.
- 3 (f) The working group shall report its findings and
- 4 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the
- 5 legislature no later than January 1, 2017.
- 6 (q) The legislative reference bureau shall assist the
- 7 working group with research, take notes at meetings, provide
- 8 minutes of meetings, and prepare the working group's final
- 9 report.

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- 10 (h) The working group shall be dissolved on June 30, 2017.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
