A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INSURANCE COVERAGE OF HEALTH SCREENINGS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that some women have
- 2 difficulty receiving proper screenings for sexually transmitted
- 3 diseases, including human immunodeficiency virus and acquired
- 4 immunodeficiency syndrome, at annual health screenings. The
- 5 legislature further finds that more than 1,200,000 people in the
- 6 United States are living with human immunodeficiency virus and
- 7 almost one in eight affected persons are unaware of the
- 8 infection. It is estimated that, each year, more than fifty
- 9 thousand cases of acquired immunodeficiency syndrome are
- 10 reported with one in four of the new infections striking those
- 11 aged between thirteen and twenty-four.
- 12 The legislature further finds that early detection is
- 13 paramount to proper healthcare and prevention of further
- 14 transmission. The legislature further finds that certain
- 15 healthcare providers do not screen specifically for some
- 16 sexually transmitted diseases, including human immunodeficiency
- 17 virus and acquired immunodeficiency syndrome, at annual



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- 1 screenings, even though the Patient Protection and Affordable
- 2 Care Act requires health insurance to cover those screenings
- 3 without a co-pay.
- 4 The purpose of this Act is to ensure insurance coverage for
- 5 sexually transmitted disease screenings, including screenings
- 6 for human immunodeficiency virus and acquired immunodeficiency
- 7 syndrome, during a woman's annual pelvic exam.
- 8 SECTION 2. Chapter 431, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 9 amended by adding a new section to part I of article 10A to be
- 10 appropriately designated and to read as follows:
- 11 "§431:10A- Human immunodeficiency virus and acquired
- 12 immunodeficiency syndrome screening coverage. (a) Each policy
- 13 of accident and health or sickness insurance providing coverage
- 14 for healthcare, except for policies that only provide coverage
- 15 for specified diseases or other limited benefit coverage, shall
- 16 provide insurance coverage for sexually transmitted disease
- 17 screenings, including screenings for human immunodeficiency
- 18 virus and acquired immunodeficiency syndrome, during a female
- 19 insured's annual gynecological exam.
- 20 (b) Each accident and health or sickness insurer shall
- 21 reimburse all costs associated with the coverage under



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- 1 subsection (a) to any physician or healthcare provider complying
- with this section."
- 3 SECTION 3. Chapter 432, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 4 amended by adding a new section to part VI of article 1 to be
- 5 appropriately designated and to read as follows:
- 6 "§432:1- Human immunodeficiency virus and acquired
- 7 immunodeficiency syndrome screening coverage. (a) Each
- 8 hospital or medical service plan contract providing coverage for
- 9 healthcare, except for plan contracts that only provide coverage
- 10 for specified diseases or other limited benefit coverage, shall
- 11 provide coverage for sexually transmitted disease screenings,
- 12 including screenings for human immunodeficiency virus and
- 13 acquired immunodeficiency syndrome, during a female insured's
- 14 annual gynecological exam.
- 15 (b) Each mutual benefit society shall reimburse all costs
- 16 associated with the coverage under subsection (a) to any
- 17 physician or healthcare provider complying with this section."
- 18 SECTION 4. Section 432D-23, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 19 amended to read as follows:
- 20 "§432D-23 Required provisions and benefits.
- 21 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, each



- 1 policy, contract, plan, or agreement issued in the State after
- 2 January 1, 1995, by health maintenance organizations pursuant to
- 3 this chapter, shall include benefits provided in sections
- 4 431:10-212, 431:10A-115, 431:10A-115.5, 431:10A-116, 431:10A-
- 116.2, 431:10A-116.5, 431:10A-116.6, 431:10A-119, 431:10A-120, 5
- 431:10A-121, 431:10A-122, 431:10A-125, 431:10A-126, 431:10A-132, 6
- 7 431:10A-133, [and] 431:10A-140, and 431:10A- , and chapter
- 431M."
- 9 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 11 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval
- 12 and shall apply to policies, contracts, and plans of health
- insurance issued or renewed after January 1, 2017. 13
