A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSIENT ACCOMMODATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that there is an
- 2 affordable housing crisis in the State that is exacerbated by
- 3 the increasing number of visitors to the State who are using
- 4 single family homes and residential condominiums as short-term
- 5 vacation rentals. According to a recent study by the Hawaii
- 6 tourism authority, approximately 22,238 residential units across
- 7 the State are being offered on websites as available for short-
- 8 term vacation rentals for under thirty days. Based on the
- 9 Hawaii tourism authority's estimate of vacation rentals in
- 10 Hawaii, many of the vacation rentals available on the island of
- 11 Oahu are operating without a legal permit. Unauthorized short-
- 12 term vacation rentals significantly impact the communities in
- 13 which they are located, including by decreasing the availability
- 14 of long-term rental housing for local residents.
- The purpose of this Act is to increase the supply of long-
- 16 term residential rental units for local residents by ensuring

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- 1 that only authorized transient vacation rentals receive and post
- 2 a transient accommodations tax certificate of registration.
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 237D-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 4 amended as follows:
- 5 1. By amending subsection (a) to read:
- 6 "(a) Each operator or plan manager as a condition
- 7 precedent to engaging or continuing in the business of
- 8 furnishing transient accommodations or in business as a resort
- 9 time share vacation plan shall register with the director the
- 10 name and address of each place of business within the State
- 11 subject to this chapter. The operator or plan manager shall
- 12 make a one-time payment as follows:
- 13 (1) \$5 for each registration for transient accommodations
- 14 consisting of one to five units;
- 15 (2) \$15 for each registration for transient accommodations
- 16 consisting of six or more units; and
- 17 (3) \$15 for each resort time share vacation plan within
- 18 the State;
- 19 upon receipt of which the director shall issue a certificate of
- 20 registration in such form as the director determines, attesting
- 21 that the registration has been made [-]; provided that the

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- 1 director shall issue a certificate of registration with the
- 2 letters "TVU", which signifies transient vacation unit, to an
- 3 operator or plan manager furnishing transient accommodations for
- 4 less than thirty days; provided further that amended
- 5 certificates of registration with the letters "TVU" and existing
- 6 registration identification numbers may be issued for existing
- 7 certificates of registration, as applicable. The registration
- 8 shall not be transferable and shall be valid only for the
- 9 operator or plan manager in whose name it is issued and for the
- 10 transaction of business at the place designated therein.
- 11 Acquisition of additional transient accommodation units after
- 12 payment of the one-time fee shall not result in additional
- 13 fees."
- 14 2. By amending subsection (d) to read:
- "(d) Failure to meet the requirements of subsection (c) or
- 16 providing a false registration identification number shall be
- 17 unlawful. The department may issue citations to any person,
- 18 including operators, plan managers, and transient accommodations
- 19 brokers, who violates subsection (c). A citation issued
- 20 pursuant to this subsection for each transient accommodation or
- 21 resort time share vacation interest, plan, or unit in violation

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1	of subsection (c) shall include a monetary fine of not less	
2	than:	
3	(1)	\$500 per day, for a first violation for which a
4		citation is issued;
5	(2)	\$1,000 per day, for a second violation for which a
6		citation is issued; and
7	(3)	\$5,000 per day, for a third and any subsequent
8		violation for which a citation is issued."
9	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed	
10	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.	
11	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Report Title:

Transient Accommodations Tax Certificate of Registration; Transient Vacation Unit; Penalties

Description:

Requires the director of taxation to issue a certificate of registration with the letters "TVU", which signifies transient vacation unit, to an operator or plan manager furnishing transient accommodations to a transient for less than thirty days; provided that amended certificates of registration with the letters "TVU" and existing registration identification numbers may be issued for existing certificates of registration, as applicable. Establishes penalties for providing a false registration identification number.

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
