A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HUMANE TREATMENT OF ANIMALS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 711, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§711- Confinement of a dog by tethering; violation.

5 (1) Except as provided in section 711-1109(1)(g), a person
6 commits the offense of confinement of a dog by tethering if the
7 person intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly tethers, fastens,
8 ties, or restrains a dog in a cruel or inhumane manner to a
9 doghouse, tree, fence, or any other stationary object or to a
10 cable trolley system:

11 (a) By a tether or chain that is less than six feet in
12 length;

13 (b) By a tether or chain that weighs more than ten per
14 cent of the weight of the dog tethered;

15 (c) By a tether or chain that does not have a swivel on at
16 least one end;



1 (d) By a tether or chain for hours or more

2 continuously; or

3 (e) Where the dog is under the age of six months;

4 provided that a person is not prohibited from using these

5 restraints when walking a dog with a hand-held leash or while a

6 dog is engaged in a supervised activity; provided further that a

7 person is not prohibited from using these restraints or from

8 restraining a dog under the age of six months while the dog is

9 engaged in an activity, including training, that is directly

10 related to shepherding or herding livestock, or when reasonably

11 necessary for the safety of the dog.

12 (2) Confinement of a dog by tethering shall be a

13 violation; provided that any person convicted under this section

14 shall be sentenced as follows:

15 (a) For a first offense, by a fine of not less than \$50

16 and not more than \$150, without the possibility of

17 suspension; and

18 (b) For a second or subsequent offense, by a fine of not

19 less than \$200 and not more than \$500, without the

20 possibility of suspension."

1 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
3 begun before its effective date.

4 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
