A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 2 by adding a new section to part XIII to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "§11- Contributions by family members of officers or
- 5 boards members of state and county contractors. (a) Any
- 6 contractor who is otherwise prohibited from making any
- 7 contribution to any candidate or candidate committee pursuant to
- **8** section 11-355 shall report any contributions made by any
- 9 immediate family members of any officer, board member, or
- 10 manager of the contractor no later than thirty days prior to
- 11 each primary election and general election.
- 12 (b) For purposes of this section:
- "Contractor" includes individuals, partnerships,
- 14 corporations, associations, or public or private organizations
- 15 of any character other than government agencies who enter into
- 16 any contract with the State, any of the counties, or any
- 17 department or agency thereof either for the rendition of



- 1 personal services, the buying of property, or furnishing of any
- 2 material, supplies, or equipment to the State, any of the
- 3 counties, any department or agency thereof, or for selling any
- 4 land or building to the State, any of the counties, or any
- 5 department or agency thereof, if payment for the performance of
- 6 the contract or payment for materials, supplies, equipment,
- 7 land, property, or the building is to be made in whole or in
- 8 part from funds appropriated by the legislative body.
- 9 "Immediate family" includes the spouse or reciprocal
- 10 beneficiary as defined in section 572C-3, and any child, parent,
- 11 grandparent, or sibling of the officer, board member, or manager
- 12 of the contractor, including the spouses and reciprocal
- 13 beneficiaries of such individuals."
- 14 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
