A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INVASIVE SPECIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general			
2	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so			
3	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2016-2017 to			
4	the department of land and natural resources division of			
5	forestry and wildlife for the immediate, coordinated management			
6	of albizia trees that threaten access to critical emergency			
7	services and transportation routes identified by the Hawaii			
8	county civil defense agency for the island of Hawaii, as			
9	follows:			
10	(1) The funds shall be expended solely for the coordinate			

- (1) The funds shall be expended solely for the coordinated management of albizia trees on the island of Hawaii, except that other plants may be incidentally removed in the process. If the project cannot be continued, funds may be transferred to another island invasive species committee to accomplish the same purpose on that island;
- (2) Albizia trees shall be completely removed from highway rights of way, and albizia trees outside the right of
