A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

	DE IT ENACIED DY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:
1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the transportation
2	of fireworks to, from, and within the State of Hawaii requires
3	the use of multiple modes or methods of transport, including
4	interstate trucking or rail, interstate maritime transportation
5	intrastate maritime transportation, and intrastate trucking.
6	The legislature also finds that, given the diversity of
7	transportation processes and modes, it is essential, and in the
8	best interest of the health and safety of the community and the
9	State's first responders, that there should be thorough
10	accounting and reporting on the importation of fireworks
11	shipments.
12	The legislature acknowledges that the current statute
13	regulating importation of fireworks establishes requirements fo

regulating importation of fireworks establishes requirements for licensed individuals or entities in accordance with section 132D-8.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes. However, to ensure a more comprehensive tracking of all shipments of fireworks imported into the State, additional requirements of those persons or entities defined as "shipper" are necessary. 1 for shipper were inadvertently omitted when the definition was 2 added in a previous legislative session. 3 The purpose of this Act is to clarify the current fireworks importation statute by: 4 5 (1) Adding a new section to delineate the responsibilities 6 of those persons or entities defined as a "shipper"; 7 (2) Allowing fireworks to be used in movie or television 8 productions and by those authorized to destroy or test 9 fireworks; and 10 (3) Making amendments regarding the dimensions of required 11 labels on display fireworks articles pyrotechnic, and 12 aerial devices. 13 SECTION 2. Chapter 132D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 14 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 15 and to read as follows: 16 "§132D- Requirements of shipper. (a) Any shipper that 17 receives fireworks that are imported into the State or 18 transported between the counties shall notify the county fire

chief of the county to which the shipment is destined, prior to

shipment, whether the shipment will be distributed from:

10	business ac	ddress of the manufacturer. The label shall be
11	approved by	the state fire council and conform to the following
12	standards:
