
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 103D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
3 designated and to read as follows:

4 "§103D- Statewide procurement database. (a) The state
5 procurement office shall establish and maintain a database of
6 all procurement contract data received pursuant to subsection
7 (b); provided that all data on the database shall be made
8 accessible to each governmental body.

9 (b) Each governmental body shall provide to the state
10 procurement office all data relating to any procurement contract
11 of the governmental body, in the form and manner prescribed by
12 the state procurement office and for inclusion in the database
13 established under subsection (a); provided that the chief
14 procurement officer of each jurisdiction shall be responsible
15 for the collection and transmittal of data to the state
16 procurement office."

17 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
18 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$100,000 or so much



1 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2016-2017 for the
2 state procurement office to establish the statewide procurement
3 database pursuant to this Act.

4 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
5 accounting and general services for the purposes of this Act.

6 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.

Procurement; State Procurement Office Database; Appropriation

Description:

Requires the state procurement office to establish a database of all government procurement contracts, accessible to each governmental body. Requires each governmental body to provide to the state procurement office all data relating to any procurement contract of the governmental body; provided that the chief procurement officer of each jurisdiction shall be responsible for the collection and transmittal of data to the state procurement office. Appropriates funds to establish the database. (SD1)
