A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTRIC VEHICLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 291-71, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§291-71 Designation of parking spaces for electric
- 4 vehicles; charging system. (a) Places of public accommodation
- 5 with at least one hundred parking spaces available for use by
- the general public shall have at least one parking space 6
- exclusively for electric vehicles and equipped with an electric 7
- vehicle charging system located anywhere in the parking 8
- structure or lot by July 1, 2012; provided that no parking space 9
- 10 designated for electric vehicles shall displace or reduce
- accessible stalls required by the Americans with Disabilities 11
- 12 Act Accessibility Guidelines. Spaces shall be designated,
- 13 clearly marked, and the exclusive designation enforced. Owners
- of multiple parking facilities within the State may designate 14
- and electrify fewer parking spaces than required in one or more 15
- 16 of their owned properties; provided that the scheduled

- 3 (b) Any owner of a place of public accommodation with at
- 4 least one hundred parking spaces available for use by the

- 7 correct the violation within ninety days from the date of the
- 8 citation. Any owner who fails to correct the violation within
- 9 ninety days shall be fined:
- 10 (1) \$1,000 for a first offense;
- 11 (2) \$2,500 for a second offense; and
- 12 (3) \$5,000 For a third or subsequent offense.
- 13 Each day of violation shall constitute a separate offense.
- 14 [(b)] (c) For the purposes of this section:
- "Electric vehicle" means:
- 16 (1) A neighborhood electric vehicle as defined in section
- 17 286-2; or
- 18 (2) A vehicle, with four or more wheels, that draws
- 19 propulsion energy from a battery with at least four
- 20 kilowatt hours of energy storage capacity that can be
- 21 recharged from an external source of electricity.
