A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PROFESSIONAL EMPLOYER ORGANIZATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to address
- professional employer organizations.
- 3 More specifically, this Act statutorily increases the fees
- 4 imposed upon professional employer organizations. The fees are
- 5 set at amounts intended to generate sufficient revenues to
- 6 entirely fund the cost to regulate professional employer
- 7 organizations.
- 8 The legislature finds that a sliding scale, based upon the
- 9 number of covered employees of a professional employer
- 10 organization, is a fair and reasonable way to establish the fee
- 11 amounts. The sliding scale is intended to prevent smaller
- 12 professional employer organizations from having to pay the same
- 13 fee amount as larger organizations.
- 14 The legislature emphasizes that the cost of regulating
- 15 professional employer organizations should be borne entirely by
- 16 the organizations through the fees. The costs should include
- 17 all direct costs as well as fringe benefit costs paid through



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appropriations to the department of budget and finance. Other 1 2 regulated businesses are subject to the same financial self-3 sufficiency policy. The legislature opposes subsidizing the regulation of professional employer organizations from the 4 5 general fund. 6 SECTION 2. Section 373L-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 7 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: Effective [July 1, 2013,] January 1, 2017, the 8 "(b) director shall collect fees in the following amounts: 9 10 (1) Registration fee \$ 500 (2) Biennial renewal fee [\$\frac{1}{5}\] based upon the average 11 12 annual count of covered employees as follows: 13 covered employees 14 covered employees 15 covered employees - covered employees \$ 16 17 or more covered employees 18 (3) Restoration fee \$1,500 19 until such time as the director amends the fees by rulemaking 20 pursuant to chapter 91."

- 1 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2017.
