A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NON-GENERAL FUNDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the judiciary should
- 2 report to the legislature on all non-general funds managed by
- 3 the judiciary, including administratively established accounts
- 4 and funds. The legislature finds it is necessary to be informed
- 5 of the total fiscal situation of the State to make sound
- 6 budgetary decisions. However, the auditor's report no. 15-16,
- 7 "Review of Special Funds, Revolving Funds, Trust Funds, and
- 8 Trust Accounts of the Judiciary", reported that "[a]ccording to
- 9 [j]udiciary personnel, sections 37-47(9), (10), and (11), Hawaii
- 10 Revised Statutes, do not apply to its special funds." As a
- 11 result, the auditor found that several trust funds and accounts
- 12 of the judiciary were not reported to the legislature.
- 13 The purpose of this Act is to impose the same non-general
- 14 fund reporting requirements on the judiciary as that established
- 15 for executive branch departments.
- 16 SECTION 2. Chapter 601, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 17 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 18 and to read as follows:

- 8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
