### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOUSING.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to provide capital
- 2 for the development of affordable rental housing.
- 3 More specifically, this Act transfers excess moneys from
- 4 the dwelling unit revolving fund, established pursuant to
- 5 section 201H-191, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and rental assistance
- 6 revolving fund, established pursuant to section 201H-123, Hawaii
- 7 Revised Statutes, to the rental housing revolving fund,
- 8 established pursuant to section 201H-202, Hawaii Revised
- 9 Statutes.
- 10 The legislature finds that more affordable rental housing
- 11 is needed by the people of Hawaii. The rental housing revolving
- 12 fund is the main source of capital from the State for affordable
- 13 rental housing projects. Thus, the legislature finds that the
- 14 rental housing revolving fund should be augmented to enable the
- 15 development of more affordable rental housing projects.
- 16 The legislature further finds that both the dwelling unit
- 17 revolving fund and rental assistance revolving fund have

- 1 balances in excess of the immediate needs of the funds.
- 2 Furthermore, the dwelling unit revolving fund provides capital
- 3 for market-priced and fee simple housing, and the legislature
- 4 finds that, at least for the immediate future, the public policy
- 5 priority should be affordable rental housing rather than market-
- 6 priced or fee-simple housing. The rental assistance revolving
- 7 fund is not particularly robust, and the legislature finds that
- 8 its proceeds should be transferred to the rental housing
- 9 revolving fund.
- 10 SECTION 2. On July 1, 2016, \$20,000,000 from the dwelling
- 11 unit revolving fund, shall be transferred to the rental housing
- 12 revolving fund.
- 13 The legislature finds that the transferred amount is in
- 14 excess of the immediate needs of the dwelling unit revolving
- 15 fund.
- 16 SECTION 3. On July 1, 2016, \$9,500,000 from the rental
- 17 assistance revolving fund shall be transferred to the rental
- 18 housing revolving fund.
- 19 The legislature finds that the transferred amount is in
- 20 excess of the immediate needs of the rental assistance revolving
- 21 fund.

- 1 SECTION 4. The director of finance shall effectuate the
- 2 transfers required by sections 2 and 3.
- 3 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
