### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATEWIDE TRAFFIC CODE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that section 291C-33,
- 2 Hawaii Revised Statutes, relating to pedestrian-control signals,
- 3 was last amended in 1981. This section needs to be updated to
- 4 include countdown timers and to clarify when a pedestrian is
- 5 allowed to cross when the countdown timer is operating.
- 6 Countdown timers show pedestrians how many seconds are left to
- 7 cross the street before the pedestrian signal changes from a
- 8 flashing "Don't Walk" to a steady "Don't Walk" or upraised palm
- 9 indication.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 291C-33, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 11 amended to read as follows:
- 12 "§291C-33 Pedestrian-control signals. Whenever special
- 13 pedestrian-control signals, exhibiting the words "Walk" or
- 14 "Don't Walk" or the symbols of a walking person or an upraised
- 15 palm are in place such signals shall indicate as follows:
- 16 (1) Walk or Walking Person. Pedestrians facing [such] the
- signal may proceed across the roadway in the direction
