### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 302A-706, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended as follows:

3 1. By amending its title to read:

4 "§302A-706 [Teacher national] National board certification 5 incentive program."

6 2. By amending subsection (a) to read:

7 "(a) There is established within the department the [teacher] national board certification incentive program to 8 recognize and support exemplary [teaching] educational practice 9 by supporting public school teachers, counselors, and school 10 psychologists who have achieved national board certification 11 12 under the certification program of the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards [-], National Board of Certified 13 14 Counselors, or National Association of School Psychologists. The [teacher] national board certification incentive program 15 16 shall provide:

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1	(1)	A \$5,000 bonus per year for each public school
2		teacher, counselor, or school psychologist who
3		maintains current national board certification;
4	(2)	\$1,500 upon completing all components of the
5		certification program of the National Board for
6		Professional Teaching Standards;
7	(3)	A reimbursement of the remainder of the national board
8		certification application fee upon achievement of
9		national board certification; and
10	(4)	An additional \$5,000 bonus per year for each public
11		school teacher, counselor, or school psychologist who
12		maintains current national board certification and who
13		[teaches] is employed at:
14		(A) A school in a focus, priority, or
15		superintendent's zone, or other similar
16		designation, as determined by the department;
17		(B) A school with a high turnover rate, as determined
18		by the department; [ <del>or</del> ]
19		(C) A hard-to-fill school, as determined by the
20		department [-] ; or

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1	(5)	An additional \$5,000 bonus per year for any public
2		school teacher, counselor, or school psychologist who
3		received a yearly bonus pursuant to paragraph (4);
4		provided that the teacher, counselor, or school
5		psychologist maintains national board certification
6		and continues working in the same school after the
7		school transitions out of the qualifying designation
8		pursuant to paragraph (4). The teacher, counselor, or
9		school psychologist shall receive the additional bonus
10		from the time the school no longer meets any of the
11		criteria under paragraph (4) until the end date of the
12		teacher, counselor, or school psychologist's ten-year
13		national board certification in effect at the time the
14		school lost its designation, or until the teacher,
15		counselor, or school psychologist is no longer
16		employed at the school, whichever occurs first."
