BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the Read to Me
- 2 International Foundation was incorporated in March 1996 as a
- 3 result of a partnership created by leading members of the
- 4 business, labor, education, faith-based, and community sectors.
- 5 The corporation operates as a charitable organization pursuant
- 6 to section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as
- 7 amended.
- 8 The legislature further finds that the organization's
- 9 mission is to share the love and joy of reading aloud. The Read
- 10 to Me International Foundation promotes reading aloud to
- 11 children through:
- 12 (1) Presentations and workshops for parents, educators and
- other interested groups;
- 14 (2) Reading sessions at schools and community gatherings;
- 15 (3) Biennial conferences; and
- 16 (4) Support for parents of young children living in
- 17 transitional and affordable housing.
