# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ADVERTISING.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 712, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated  
3 and to read as follows:

4           "§712-    Indecent advertising. (1) A person commits the  
5 offense of indecent advertising if a person:

6           (a) Uses in any print, broadcast, electronic  
7           advertisements, or directories that include the word  
8           "massage", "relaxation", "spa", "escort", or "body  
9           rubs", images depicting any person being advertised as  
10           a massage therapist, relaxation therapist, or escort  
11           in nude condition; or

12           (b) Refers to the intimate areas of a person being  
13           advertised as a massage therapist, relaxation  
14           therapist, or escort in any print, broadcast,  
15           electronic advertisement, or directories that includes  
16           the word "massage", "relaxation", "spa", "escort", or  
17           "body rubs".



1           (2) The publisher or producer of a print, broadcast, or  
2 electronic advertising medium shall not publish or broadcast an  
3 advertisement or listing for massage therapy, relaxation  
4 therapy, or an escort service that does not comply with this  
5 section.

6           (3) A publisher or producer who obtains a written or  
7 electronic agreement from the advertiser that the advertiser  
8 will not advertise any service in violation of state or federal  
9 law shall be entitled to a rebuttable presumption of compliance  
10 with this section.

11           (4) Indecent advertising is a misdemeanor."

12           SECTION 2. Section 712-1210, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
13 amended by adding seven new definitions to be appropriately  
14 inserted and to read as follows:

15           "Advertise" includes but is not limited to:

- 16           (a) Issuing any card, sign, or device to any person;
- 17           (b) Causing, permitting, or allowing any sign or marking  
18           on or in any building, vehicle, or structure;
- 19           (c) Advertising in any newspaper or magazine;
- 20           (d) Broadcasting commercials by airwave transmission; or



1        (e) Distributing commercial messages through any  
2                    electronic communication system, including but not  
3                    limited to the Internet.

4            "Escort" means any person who provides company to other  
5 persons for amusement, companionship, or entertainment at any  
6 public or private location in exchange for a fee; provided that  
7 the term shall not include companionship services for the aged  
8 or infirm under section 387-1.

9            "Intimate areas" has the same meaning as in section  
10 711-1111.

11           "Massage therapist" has the same meaning as in section  
12 452-1.

13           "Massage therapy" has the same meaning as in section 452-1.

14           "Relaxation therapist" means any person who engages in the  
15 occupation or practice of relaxation therapy for compensation.

16           "Relaxation therapy" means any method of practicing healing  
17 arts other than massage therapy, including but not limited to  
18 pedicure, manicure, reflexology, and spa treatment services."

19           SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that  
20 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were  
21 begun before its effective date
