A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE SALE OF E-LIQUID.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 The legislature finds that according to the
- 2 Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, calls to poison
- control centers across the country related to exposure to 3
- nicotine in cigarettes have grown considerably since 2010. 4
- Poison experts warn that concentrated nicotine in liquid form is 5
- significantly toxic, even in small doses, as poisonings related 6
- to e-liquid containers can occur when nicotine is inhaled or 7
- 8 absorbed through the skin or eyes.
- The legislature further finds that the packaging and use of 9
- electronic smoking devices is potentially hazardous to the 10
- health of Hawaii residents, including Hawaii's children, yet 11
- 12 many liquids for electronic smoking devices are offered in
- 13 flavors and scents that are appealing to children. There are
- currently no packaging requirements for the sale of e-liquid 14
- containers. Stringent packaging and labeling requirements for 15
- e-liquid containers will protect young children from inadvertent 16
- exposure to the contents of electronic smoking device cartridges 17



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- 1 and also inform consumers whether an e-liquid product contains
- 2 nicotine, a highly addictive substance.
- 3 The purpose of this Act is to establish safe and
- 4 responsible packaging requirements for e-liquid containers to
- 5 protect Hawaii's children and ensure consumers are better
- 6 informed regarding the contents of electronic smoking device
- 7 products.
- 8 SECTION 2. Chapter 328J, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 9 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 10 and to read as follows:
- 11 "§328J- Sale of certain e-liquid containers prohibited.
- 12 (a) It shall be unlawful for any person or business to sell,
- 13 offer for sale, or introduce into commerce in the State an
- 14 e-liquid container unless the e-liquid container constitutes
- 15 child-resistant packaging.
- 16 (b) It shall be unlawful for any person or business to
- 17 sell, offer for sale, or introduce into commerce in the State an
- 18 e-liquid container for an e-liquid product containing nicotine
- 19 unless the packaging for the e-liquid product clearly and
- 20 legibly states:

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1	(1) "Warning - contains nicotine. Not for sale to persons
2	under 21 years of age."; and
3	(2) "This product is not FDA approved."
4	(c) Any person convicted of violating this section shall
5	be guilty of a misdemeanor.
6	(d) Any person or business that violates this section
7	shall be liable to any person injured as a result of the
8	violation."
9	SECTION 3. Section 328J-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
10	amended by adding three new definitions to be appropriately
11	inserted and to read as follows:
12	""Child-resistant packaging" means packaging that is
13	designed or constructed to be significantly difficult for
14	children under five years of age to open or obtain a toxic or
15	harmful amount of the substance contained therein within a
16	reasonable time and not difficult for adults to use properly.
17	This term does not include packaging which all such children
18	cannot open or obtain a toxic or harmful amount within a
10	reasonable time

1	"E-liquid" means a liquid product, whether or not it
2	contains nicotine, that is intended to be vaporized and inhaled
3	using an electronic smoking device.
4	"E-liquid container" means a bottle or other container of
5	e-liquid. This term does not include a container holding liquid
6	that is intended for use in an electronic smoking device if the
7	container is pre-filled and sealed by the manufacturer and is
8	not intended to be opened by the consumer."
9	SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
10	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2017.

Report Title:

E-liquid; Electronic Smoking Devices; Packaging Requirements; Prohibitions; Penalties

Description:

Beginning January 1, 2017, prohibits the sale of an e-liquid container for an electronic smoking device unless the container is packaged in child-resistant packaging and labeled with warning language, if applicable. Establishes penalties.

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
