### A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO MANAGE ALBIZIA TREES ON THE ISLAND OF HAWAII.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that albizia, Falcataria
- 2 moluccana, is an invasive species that presents an increasingly
- 3 costly threat to the economy, critical infrastructure, and
- 4 public safety on the island of Hawaii. The likelihood of
- 5 albizia trees falling and the long distances between residential
- 6 areas and emergency services add significantly to the
- 7 uncertainty of emergency response capability, resulting in the
- 8 potential loss of human life following a hurricane. Further,
- 9 the pre-planned removal of each albizia tree costs significantly
- 10 less than the combined direct and indirect costs of removal if
- 11 and when it falls into a road, power line, or building. The Big
- 12 Island Invasive Species Committee has demonstrated the
- 13 effectiveness and necessity of a coordinated approach to
- 14 controlling the growth and spread of albizia trees.
- 15 The purpose of this Act is to make an appropriation for the
- 16 control of albizia trees on the island of Hawaii.

1	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general				
2	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$5,000,000 or so much				
3	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2016-2017 to the				
4	department of land and natural resources division of forestry				
5	and wildlife for the immediate, coordinated management of				
6	albizia trees that threaten access to critical emergency				
7	services and transportation routes identified by the Hawaii				
8	county civil defense agency for the island of Hawaii, as				
9	follows:				
10	(1) The funds shall be expended solely for the coordinated				
11	management of albizia trees on the island of Hawaii,				
12	except that other plants may be incidentally removed				
13	in the process. If the project cannot be continued,				
14	funds may be transferred to another island invasive				
15	species committee to accomplish the same purpose on				
16	that island;				
17	(2) Albizia trees shall be completely removed from highway				
18	rights of way, and albizia trees outside the right of				
19	way that are deemed non-hazardous shall be treated and				
20	left in place; and

1	(3)	(3) Control of albizia trees shall be concentrated in the		
2	following areas:			
3		(A)	The two-mile stretch of highway 132 between Lava	
4			Tree state park and Pahoa;	
5		(B)	Isolated patches of albizia trees between	
6			Kalapana and Pahoa;	
7		(C)	Isolated patches of albizia trees between Pahoa	
8			and Keaau;	
9		(D)	The hospital corridor, particularly the segment	
10			of Waianuenue avenue from Komohana street to	
11			Akolea road, the segment of Akolea road from	
12			Waianuenue avenue to Kaumana drive, and Puainako	
13			street from highway 11 to Kaumana drive; and	
14		(E)	Any additional areas of the island of Hawaii as	
15			deemed necessary by the Big Island Invasive	
16			Species Committee.	
17	SECT	'ION 3	. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the	
18	department of land and natural resources division of forestry			
19	and wildlife for use by the Big Island Invasive Species			
20	Committee	for	the purposes of this Act.
