- 3 "SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2014,
- 4 and shall be repealed on June 30, [2018;] 2023; provided that
- 5 this Act shall apply to permit applications filed with the State
- 6 or county after December 31, 2013."
- 7 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Broadband Permits; Automatic Approval; Construction

Description:

Extends until 6/30/2023 the provisions of Act 264, SLH 2013, which requires the State and the counties to take action within sixty days for broadband-related permit applications, requires the State to take action within one hundred forty-five days for use applications for broadband facilities within the conservation district, establishes other requirements regarding broadband-related permits, and subjects weight load for utility poles to capacities established by the FCC and PUC.
