A BILL FOR AN ACT

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE HAWAII CONSTITUTION TO REQUIRE THE LEGISLATURE TO FUND BEFORE-, AFTER- AND INTERSESSION-SCHOOL CARE PROGRAMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to propose an
- 2 amendment to article X of the Constitution of the State of
- 3 Hawaii to require the legislature to annually appropriate moneys
- 4 to support K-12 before-, after-, and intersession-school care
- 5 programs.
- 6 SECTION 2. Article X of the Constitution of the State of
- 7 Hawaii is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately
- 8 designated and to read as follows:
- 9 "BEFORE-, AFTER- AND INTERSESSION-SCHOOL CARE PROGRAMS"
- 10 Section . The legislature shall annually appropriate
- 11 moneys out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii for
- 12 the purpose of supporting before-, after- and intersession-
- 13 school care programs serving grades kindergarten through
- 14 twelve."
- 15 SECTION 3. The question to be printed on the ballot shall
- 16 be as follows:
