A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HUNTING ON PRIVATE LANDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to require those who
- 2 wish to access private land for hunting to obtain written
- 3 permission from the landowner.
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 183D-26, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 5 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 6 "(a) No person shall enter upon any land or premises
- 7 belonging to, held, or occupied by another, for the purpose of
- 8 hunting or to take any kind of wildlife including game without
- 9 first having obtained written permission from the owner or a
- 10 duly appointed agent, if the owner is the occupier or holder, or
- 11 if the owner has let another occupy or hold the same, without
- 12 having first obtained the written permission of the occupier or
- 13 holder thereof, or the duly appointed agent of the occupier or
- 14 holder. For purposes of this subsection, "written permission"
- 15 includes an expression of permission conveyed and stored by
- 16 electronic means."

- 1 SECTION 3. Nothing in this Act shall be construed to
- 2 infringe on the traditional and customary rights set forth in
- 3 article XII, section 7, of the Hawaii State Constitution.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 5 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 6 begun before its effective date.
- 7 SECTION 5. New statutory material is underscored.
- 8 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on January 7, 2059.
